A new main show tape was not made to go with this retrofit; you are to switch back to Chuck E.'s "Hit Parade" tape. I've also included an "Eerie Sounds" background cassette tape in your kit. It is strictly up to your district manager whether or not background music is to be played in your store. Check with your district manager before using this tape.

This show may be installed as soon as it's received, and will run through October 31, 1985.

CHUCK E. CHEESE

FANGS: Cut set of fangs in half. Hot glue to upper jaw 2" back from center front.

POINTER:

Remains pinned into hand from "Back to School" show.

widows peak on forehead. T-Pin to head at center, cheeks, and jaw line. Allow exces fabric to collect behind ears. Brush straight back and hair spray smooth.

CAPE: Slit down center back neck 15". Pull over shoulders and pin to body over shirt front. Trim excess length from bottom of cape.

SHIRTFRONT/BOW-TIE:
Center and pin to body
in 4 places.

DRACULA WIG	1
SHIRTFRONT/BOW-TIE	1
CAPE	1
FANGS	1

MR. MUNCH

HEAD-DRESS:

Cut band on each headress. Open out flat,
overlap, and staple all
6 together to form one
long headress. Hot
glue any loose feathers
in place. T-pin securely
to head.

TOMAHAWK:

Wrap fingers around handle and safety pin together.



BONE NECKLACE:

Pin to neck edge.

BROWN FRINGED VEST:

(optional from "Bandstand Show") Slip on and velcro down back.

SKULL ON STICK:

hit her beak.

BLACK FRINGE BANNER: Remove letters from

banner. (use else-where in store) turn fringe face down and pin to top edge of red sequin dress.

PASQUALLY



Slip ends of eyepatch beneath hair and T-pin to head. Eyepatch should rest on cheek, clear of eyelid movement.

HOOK:

Remove fabric hand,
turn metal fingers back
against hand plate.
Poke a hole in base of
hook. Tie-wrap hook
thru hole in handplate.
Tuck sleeve into base of hook.

PIRATE HAT: T-pin securely to head.

SWORD: Wrap fingers through handle and safety pin around sword.

VEST: (optional) sli on and velcro down the back.

EYEPATCH (option	


JASPER T. JOWLS



Stuff with tissue and T-pin to head securely.

I.D. NUMBERS:

Align top edge of numbers with stripes in shirt. Adhere with double face tape and pins.



BALL AND CHAIN:
Slip over top of
Banjo. Secure with
a dot of hot glue.

BACKDROP



Center the banner across the back wall of your center stage. Staple it to the wall.*

*The ropes and grommets were omitted from the banner this time for the sake of appearance. If these items are necessary for your particular installation, please let me know, otherwise, all future banners will be done without ropes and grommets.
