YOUR NAF DOLLARS AT WORK

THREE NEW AD SLICKS

This packet includes copies of three new ad slicks for your use. These can be used in newspaper advertising, in-store coupons, bouncebacks, etc. Each of these is standard newspaper ad size and have space allowed for an expiration date and addresses. These ad slicks are:

1. "Eating Out Coupons"

This is a black-and-white conversion of the Free Standing Insert. Each ad slick includes 5 recommended coupon copy blocks. These coupons are being used by the Company on the Free Standing Insert. To date, statistics show the "Family Pak, \$12.89" coupon represents approximately 65% of the coupons redeemed.

This ad is 3 columns by $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".

2. "Meal Deal" Ad

The second ad slick is the "Meal Deal" which includes suggested copy within the ad. You can also have your newspaper cut out this offer and pubset your own meal deal.

This ad is 3 columns by $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".

3. "Boings for the Buck"

The third ad slick is a "token deal" with space for you to fill in the number of tokens you are offering for a dollar. The company used this ad during the first quarter, but the results have been mixed.

This ad is 2 columns by $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".
