SHOWBIZ MAJOR NEW BUSINESS IN SAGINAW

The new ShowBiz Pizza Place, opening Wednesday, October 13th at 5105 Bay Rd. in Saginaw, represents a substantial investment in the local business community. The restaurant/entertainment facility encompasses more than 10,200 square feet and can accommodate over 370 customers at a time. The building and fixtures represent an investment of more than one and one fourth million dollars.

The Saginaw restaurant is the 106th addition to the rapidly growing chain of ShowBiz Pizza Places, which are already open in 18 states, mostly in the Midwest, South and Southeast. Saginaw manager Richard Bucich said that his restaurant will have 55 employees and, he added, "Our payroll will run well over \$400,000 a year."

ShowBiz restaurants are combination dining and entertainment establishments. In addition to a menu which includes pizza, sandwiches, salad bar, ice cream, cotton candy, soft drinks, wine and beer, there are over 60 new electronic games and a dining room featuring a 42-foot stage with life-size animated characters who sing and entertain every few minutes.

The restaurants are divided into three basic areas: The dining room with the stage, a playroom for the games and a room with a wide-screen television and several sit-down games.

Eight hilarious animated characters, over 60 new electronic games, pizza, a salad bar and more combine to create ShowBiz Pizza Place, opening in Saginaw at 5105 Bay Rd. on Wednesday, October 13th.

The Saginaw restaurant will be the 106th ShowBiz Pizza Place, most of which are located in the midwest and south.

One of the main attractions of this family-oriented restaurant is a zany group of animated, bigger than life, animal characters who seem almost alive as they sing, play instruments and perform comedy routines.

Billy Bob, an amiable hillbilly bear, and the Birthday Bird, his Happy "Bird-day" Buddy, serve as hosts. In addition to appearing in the show, Billy Bob, impersonated by an actor in a costume, circulates among the crowd making visitors welcome and serving as a special host at children's birthday parties.

"The Rock-Afire Explosion" includes Rolfe de Wolfe, the MC; Fatz, a piano-playing gorilla who has proven to be the hit of the show; Dook, the dog drummer; Beach Bear, guitarist; Mitzi, the mouse vocalist; and the hilarious Looney Bird, a sort of heckler to the whole performance. A new show is presented every few minutes.

In addition to the entertainment, ShowBiz Pizza Place features a Play Room with over sixty new electronic games and a special section for children with scaled-down games, a slide, merry-go-round and a magic cave. Free game tokens are given with food orders.



There are two dining rooms, the Show Room and the Sports Room. The Sports Room has a warm, rustic decor and the walls feature pictures of local athletes and teams. There is also a big-screen TV and numerous sit-down video games.

The pizzas are made from fresh dough daily and have gained a superior rating in recent independent surveys. A salad bar, sandwiches, ice cream, soft drinks and beer complete the menu.

"The Rock-Afire Explosion" is the brain child of Aaron Fechter, a 27-year old inventor businessman whose Orlando, Florida, company designs and builds all of the shows for ShowBiz Pizza Place.

Fechter graduated from the University of South Florida at 19 and built his first Electronimated show at the age of 21. His electronic genius was obvious at an early age. At four, he took radios apart. At five, he put them back together again. At eleven, he had a TV repair business but, he says, "I had to close that down because I couldn't lift the sets!"

ShowBiz Pizza Place, Inc., is a co-development of Brock Hotel
Corporation (formerly Topeka Inn Management, Inc.) and Fechter's
company, Creative Engineering, Inc., owned 80% by BHC. Brock Hotel
Corporation operates more than 60 hotels and resort properties in 22
states. BHC is headed by Robert L. Brock, who built the company from a
single Holiday Inn in Topeka, Kansas, into one of the nation's largest
and most successful food and lodging chains.

ShowBiz Pizza Place is a natural extension of the company's highly successful background in both food service and family entertainment. Brock Hotel Corporation was the first full-scale developer of the Holiday Inn Holidome concept, a giant indoor family entertainment center. The concept has proven to be one of the most successful in the notel industry and BHC's role in its development has been nationally recognized. The company also ranks among the nation's largest in total food sales.
