

I received the copy of your memo to Mickey Powell dated April 8, 1981, concerning the name changes for the characters.

The very day I decided that the spelling changes for the names would be good for the development of the characters, I called Mickey to let him know. I informed him by phone that these spelling changes need not occur immediately or even in the near future, but should be done in time for the next printing or at some other reasonable time.

As far as you are concerned, I asked simply that Mickey let me know when the changes would be scheduled and what the basis for the schedule was. I depended on him to coordinate it properly.
